



Double Header Games : League Instructions

With the amount games lost due to Covid 19 or the weather "double headers" may be brought in to ease the fixture congestion.

Guidance to be shared amongst the managers:

The games in total should not exceed 100 mins (ie: both games combined).

Timing guide

Two separate matches shall be played and the results recorded separately

U10, & U11s - 15 minutes each way per game

U12s, U13s & U14s - 20 minutes each way per game

U15s, U16s & U18s - 25 minutes each way per game

All timings should be agreed prior to the match with both teams & the referee

Costs

Pitch costs - where a team has incurred additional costs hosting a double header these should be shared between both Clubs. The host Club must notify the away team of these costs in advance of the fixture.

Referee fees - where a club pay their match officials, the cost of a Referee for a double Header will be shared between the two Clubs. The host Club must notify the away team of these costs in advance of the fixture.
